Welcome to Sharon Entsminger who is our guest speaker today. She will be speaking on Senior Marketing, and she will take questions at the end.

Sharon Entsminger is the Marketing and Communications Supervisor at Chesterfield Parks and Recreation where she oversees department communications including publications, website, media relations, graphic design, outreach, and social media. She holds a BS in Therapeutic Recreation and MS in Leisure Service Management. Sharon has a long history in parks and recreation which includes working in therapeutic recreation, with older adults, in athlo%etics, facility management, and special events. She also served on the faculty at VCU for 12 years. She is a CPRP and active member of VRPS and NRPA.

Some Action Points to implement:

- Take and use photos of your Seniors to use in your publicity.
- Which media do Senior's use? Remember only 25% of Seniors use Facebook. Emailing words and pictures reaches 70%. Fitness Health Clubs only reach 25% of Seniors.
- Do demographic research in your area and analysis of program offerings and costs for seniors. What are the scheduled times, social events, Income?
- Message your seniors to "Get Stronger" by participating in your programs. Your goal is not to maintain.
- Educate staff to be more friendly, respectful, engaging, polite, and happy.
- Send members birthday cards.
- Assess your style are you Pro-Active or Reactive?
- Posters should have contrasting color with large font and images.
- Stop using 25% discounts-because seniors will pay for quality.

- Market your health topics with Medical Professionals. Describe the benefits of your classes. "How you feel at age 70 depends on what you do at age 55.
- Is your logo recognizable.
- Use short testimonial video clips to market your programs.
- Send out reminder emails because seniors forget.
- Does anyone have any questions for Sharon or anything they would like to share?
